ORDER

IT APPEARING THAT the facilities of the Circuit Court of the City of Fredericksburg pose a danger to the health, welfare and safety of court employees and the public,

it is hereby ADJUDGED and ORDERED that the City Council take immediate steps to improve air quality in the Circuit Court building and to locate and remove ALL hazards and conditions, which improvement shall include but not be limited to the removal of mold. ALL inspections and work should be done by professionals.


The Council is further directed to find alternate facilities for the operation of the Court and the Clerk's Office for immediate relocation of services until and during the time of remediation.

It is further ordered that, should alternate facilities not be found, the Clerk's Office will be closed pursuant to Virginia Code Section 17.1-207(A)(3) during the periods when any remedial work is being done, It being determined that continuing to work in the building during remediation efforts would be detrimental to the health and safety of the Clerk's Office staff and the public.
