AFFIDAVIT
IN SUPPORT OF A SEARCH WARRANT

Before me the undersigned Magistrate, in the County of Stafford, Commonwealth of Virginia, came this the 6th day of May 2008, Detective D R Lenhart of the Stafford County Sheriff's Office, assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division. Your Affiant has been a police officer for approximately twenty-eight years and has investigated numerous cases.

Your Affiant respectfully requests a search warrant for the mobile home located at 7 Walt Way, Stafford VA 22405 (Stafford County) The residence is further described as a white mobile home trimmed in brown. The number 7 is clearly posted on the front side. There is a small wooden deck that leads to the white front door.

Your Affiant bases the probable cause for the search warrant on the following. On Monday May 5, 2008 at approximately 2140 hours, Stafford County Deputies were called to 7 Walt Way for a domestic violence type case. When they arrived, they spoke with a person who identified herself as a relative of one

of the residents at the address. She advised deputies she was concerned about the well-being of the occupants as she was aware they had been arguing and fighting earlier in the evening. She and another person had tried to raise someone inside by knocking on the door, but no one answered.

Responding Deputies knocked on the front door and got no response. As they were checking the rear of the mobile home, Deputy Mileto looked through a back window and observed a male sitting on a couch in the living room. He observed what he believed to be blood coming from the male's mouth. He also noticed the male subject was not moving. He advised other deputies on the scene and a forced entry was made. Inside the home, deputies discovered an adult male and an adult female dead in the living room. Both had obvious head wounds. A handgun was in the deceased males hand. Deputies then performed a sweep of the mobile home and found two infants, each laying in a crib, with obvious wounds to the head. Both babies were transported to hospitals and have since been pronounced dead.

Based on the aforementioned statement of facts, your affiant respectfully requests a search warrant for the mobile home described above. The purpose of the search is to seize guns, ammunition, weapons of any kind, blood samples, body fluids, bloody clothing, hairs, fibers, bloody furniture, latent fingerprints, personal papers, financial records, documentation relating to the relationship between the victims, computers, disks, cd's and related items, measurements and photographs of the scene.
